RACES – At this time, we are planning just one large race for each gender.

BOYS – 11:30 a.m.

GIRLS - 12:10 p.m.

COURSE – Each gender will run the same course of 3200 meters. The course is set up as two repeat loops of 1600 meters so the spectators will have plenty of opportunity to watch. A map will be found at adesports.com, under the MS CC Championship tab.

ENTRIES – Due on athletic.net by Friday, September 30th at 11:59 pm. The event is listed as Wisconsin MS Cross Country Championship. If you do not have an account, do not wait to set this up as you are not granted immediate access.

TEAM/BUS parking – Buses will unload and be directed as to where to park. Buses are to unload between 9:30 a.m. until 10:15 a.m.

PARKING – CARPOOL PLEASE. SPECTATOR PARKING will be open at 10:15 a.m. Please share this request with your families. Request/Remind – They don't obviously need to carpool the whole way – just coordinate in town if possible and help relieve parking issues at the course. I STRONGLY REQUEST that you urge carpooling.

SPECTATORS – There will be a \$5 admission fee to cover the costs of the golf course, bathrooms, awards and meet management, etc. Children 10 and Under will be free admission.

CONCESSIONS – Concessions will be available and we ask that your team and families are aware of this and ask for no carry ins. The concessions are part of the financial agreement to allow us to host the event on their property and we hope to be welcome back due to your support.
