ENTRY/FEE Entry Fee - \$225 per gender/\$425 for both genders.
ALL FEES to be paid ONLINE as previous years. Any checks that are mailed to the school will not be returned, but will be shredded. When you begin to register, you will first need to complete the credit card authorization to receive access to registration.

Credit cards - Are not charged until the day following the meet. This is a preauthorization until that time. Your receipt/invoice can always be viewed right where you register – View Invoice tab.

REGISTRATION Due on athletic.net – **August 21st by NOON**. You are to register your whole roster. Everyone is varsity and will run in the same race. The top 7 will score and displace. Entries are due early as we print all the students' names and school on the bibs. Please double/triple check your athlete's names/spellings. **Please register the whole roster, even the maybe students.** Those who join late will still be running; however, they will not have their name on their bib.

TEAM PACKETS Coaches can pick up their team's bibs/pins at the finish line tent upon arrival.

TENT AREA The tent area can be seen on the course map link. It will also be marked with signs upon arriving.

AWARDS Medals 1st thru 20th for all three divisions, both genders. Team awards for top three teams. There will be an awards tent set up near the finish line where athletes can pick up their medals. Team plaques can be picked up by a coach after the scores have been posted and made official. **NO AWARDS will be shipped.**

BUS PARKING All buses will park on site as we did in 2025.

TRAINER There will be an athletic trainer on site from 6:30 p.m. until the last runner crosses the finish line. Athletic trainer will be available on site as well as EMS. These services will **NOT** be available for existing injuries or taping purposes with the number of students participating. Plan appropriately. **Please bring ice with you as we will be limited in access to ice.**

SPECTATOR **All parking passes/admission will be sold online.** You will not be able to park on site without a parking pass. Parking passes can be purchased at adesports.com as well as by clicking on the SPECTATOR PARKING link as well. adesports.com/neenah-nightfall-920

Please remind all your team members to share with FRIENDS that there is no parking available without a pass. We CANNOT HAVE parking on the town road in the dark. PLEASE MAKE THIS AN EMPHASIS throughout the week.

OTHER THINGS TO KNOW

- A number of the students have never run a race at night. When the sun goes down – the energy changes. Enjoy it.
- Bring your own water to drink and ice for injuries as necessary.
- Take your trash with you.
- You will need some way to light your tent area (glow sticks / battery operated lights etc. – kids seem to be creative with this if you let them)
- May want a tarp for ground cover as you may have dew on the grass in the evening
- Bug spray – we will fog the main areas, but it won't take care of everything.
- Limited concessions will be available
- T-shirts will be available for \$25 – please share this info with your runners.
- Stay off tees and greens
- STAY ON THE CC COURSE – We want to be welcome back, so poor judgement by any of the students will not reflect well, obviously.

CAN WE.....

If the kids want to know something.... Remember it is a real meet with all the same rules as any other meet. It is at night; I do think it's pretty cool... but it's not a "glow run or color run" so to speak. The glow sticks can be worn as jewelry if so desired, but it would be considered jewelry and worn as such. Face painting – No, you cannot wear per WIAA. Also, it's dark and there are not going to be any special lights that make the paint look "cool" necessarily. SO, TO ANSWER ALL QUESTIONS I've ever received – if you can't do it at any other meet, you can't do it at this meet. If it's legal, you don't have to email me to ask if it's okay... it's on you.

Reference from the previous night meets – Rarely have the kids worn glow sticks while running. They have them on and around, but many do not choose to race with them. I think it sounds cool at first and then the kids get annoyed by them because they aren't used to running with plastic tubes around their necks. They yank them off while running and it is the most "picked up trash" item after the meet.

Again, you can wear them. Just ask the kids to take them with them
